Berlin Municipal Galleries' **KGB-Kunstwoche** returns again this year to take place in 31 galleries across Berlin's twelve districts. The seventh KGB-Kunstwoche is set to run **from 28 August to 6 September 2020**.

In **34 exhibitions and numerous other events** around the city and online, Berlin Municipal Galleries brings art to its audience with a creative concept. New paths are being forged with a fun, joyful experience of discovery that adheres to the current social distancing and hygiene rules.

The exhibitions feature explorations of current social issues using a wide variety of media including photography, painting, drawing, sculpture, installation, performance, video, and digital art, and reflect the diversity of Berlin's art scene.

"Fragile Times" at Galerie im Körnerpark focuses on the critical topic of **climate change** combined with the demand for a new relationship between humans and the natural world. In the "It's Now" exhibition at the Alte Schule Adlershof gallery, the climate crisis theme is expanded to include other future-related topics and current social issues.

Urban space and the cityscape as reflected in social processes are explored in the group exhibitions "City (Un)limited—The Dream of your own House" at Schloss Biesdorf and "Porous City. Thresholds in Urbanity" at Kunstraum Kreuzberg/Bethanien. Urban transformations are presented from a photographic perspective in both Maria Sewcz's show "ÜberStädte" at Haus am Kleistpark, and in Götz Lemberg's "SPREE – CUTS. Porträt einer StadtFlussLandschaft" at projektraum alte feuerwache. At studio im HOCHHAUS, artists investigate the influence of city inhabitants on architecture.

The five **KGB bike tours** on Sunday, 30 August 2020, are a special highlight. The new event format takes participants to several exhibition venues where gallery directors, curators, and artists provide an introduction to current exhibitions and offer insights into the main focus of Berlin Municipal Galleries.

Berlin's 34 municipal galleries occupy a total of 10,000 m2 of exhibition space and present up to 200 exhibitions involving around 1200 artists every year.
